



Eligibility and Applications

Selection Process

Participants are selected based on the eligibility requirements below and the selection committee will be inclusive of the GFP directors and independent industry leaders.

Selections

- ➔ The aviation camp is targeted at all qualifying Grade 8 and 12 girl learners.
- ➔ Have demonstrated advanced skills and serious interest in science, technology, engineering, and/or math in their academic studies.
- ➔ Intend to pursue higher education and/or careers in aviation, space, or any other STEAM-related careers.
- ➔ Exhibit maturity, flexibility, and open-mindedness.

Special Selection process

- ➔ Places will be reserved for exceptional girl students from previously disadvantaged schools, particularly those with no access to the internet and other resources required for the online application.
- ➔ GFP will identify several previously disadvantaged schools and engage teachers in those schools. The teachers will then assist in recommending girl students for the camp. The GFP team will conduct the final selection of the girls after various workshops and interactions with the students.

Selection Timeline

4 February , 2022: - Applications open with our partner schools

7 February , 2022: - Applications open online

28 February , 2022: - Applications closed

1 March - 7 March :- Interview , Final decisions will be made First week of march. All applicants will be notified of the results of their application.
